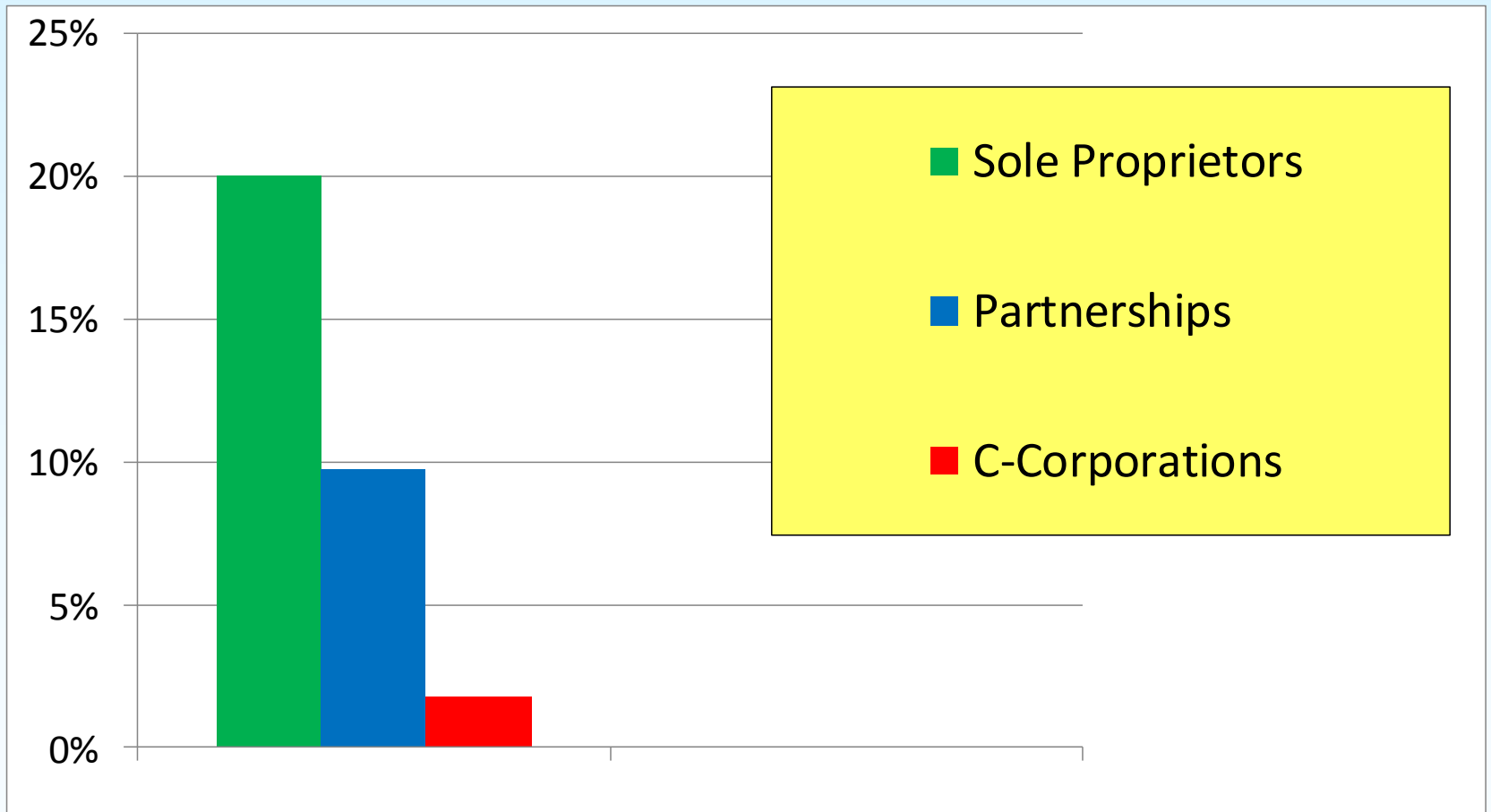

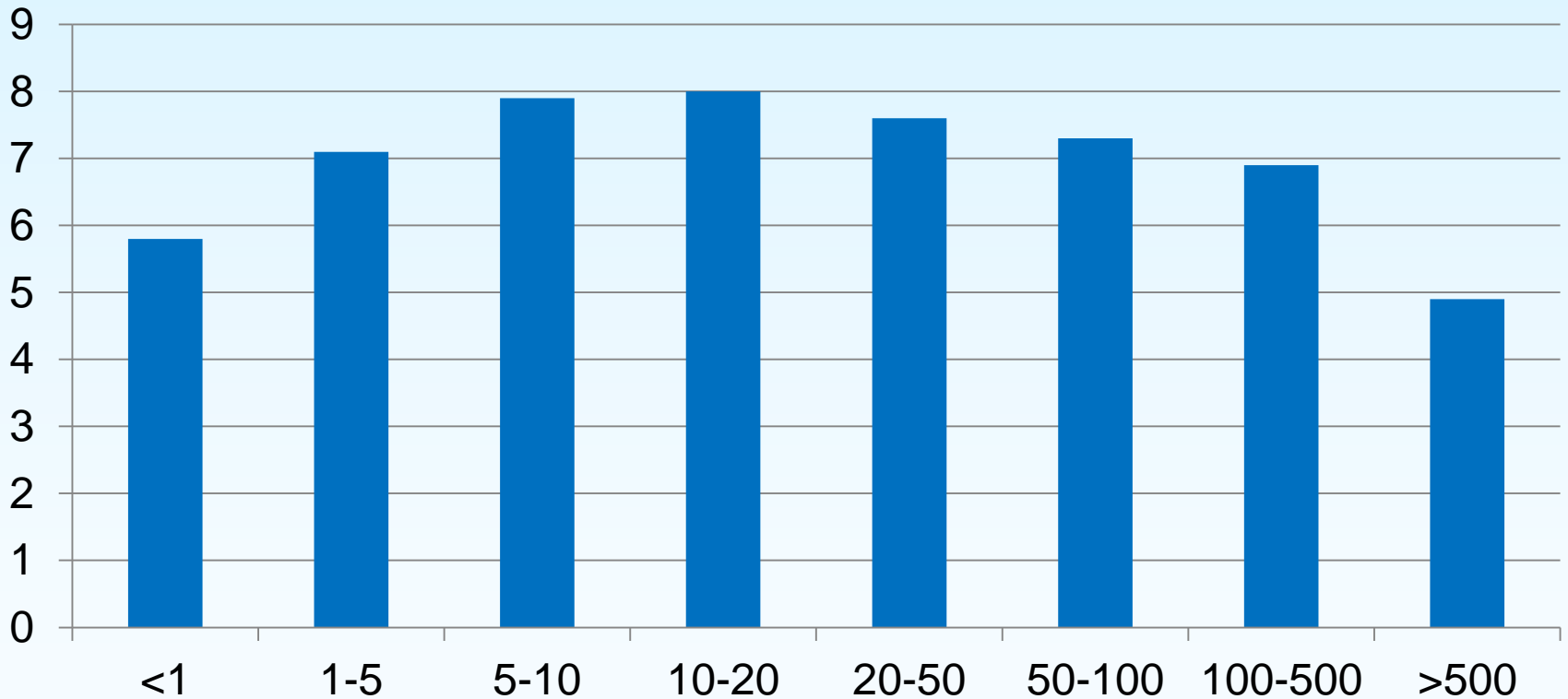
Profitability of Local in 2008

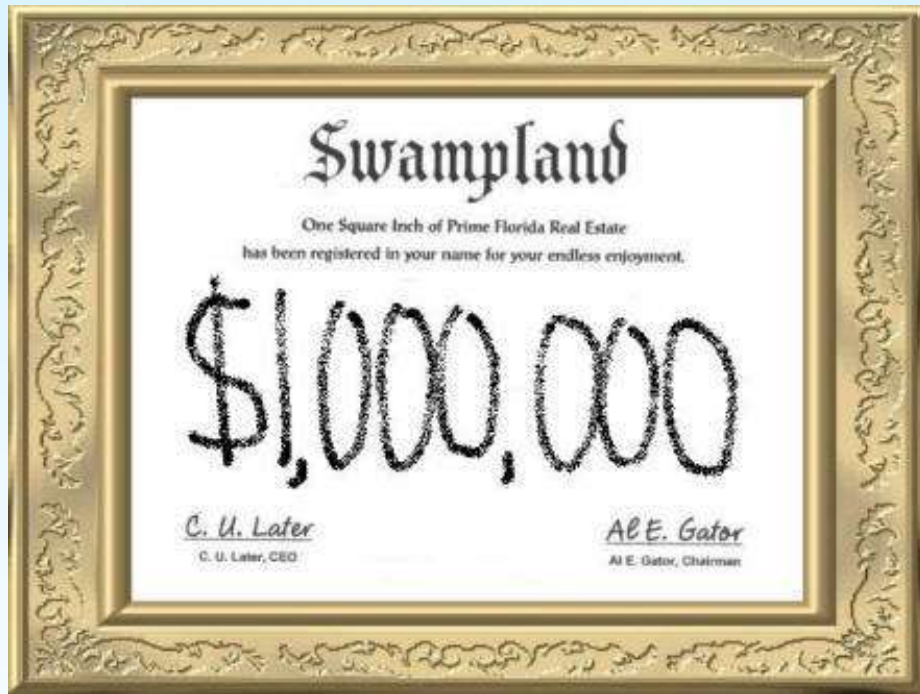

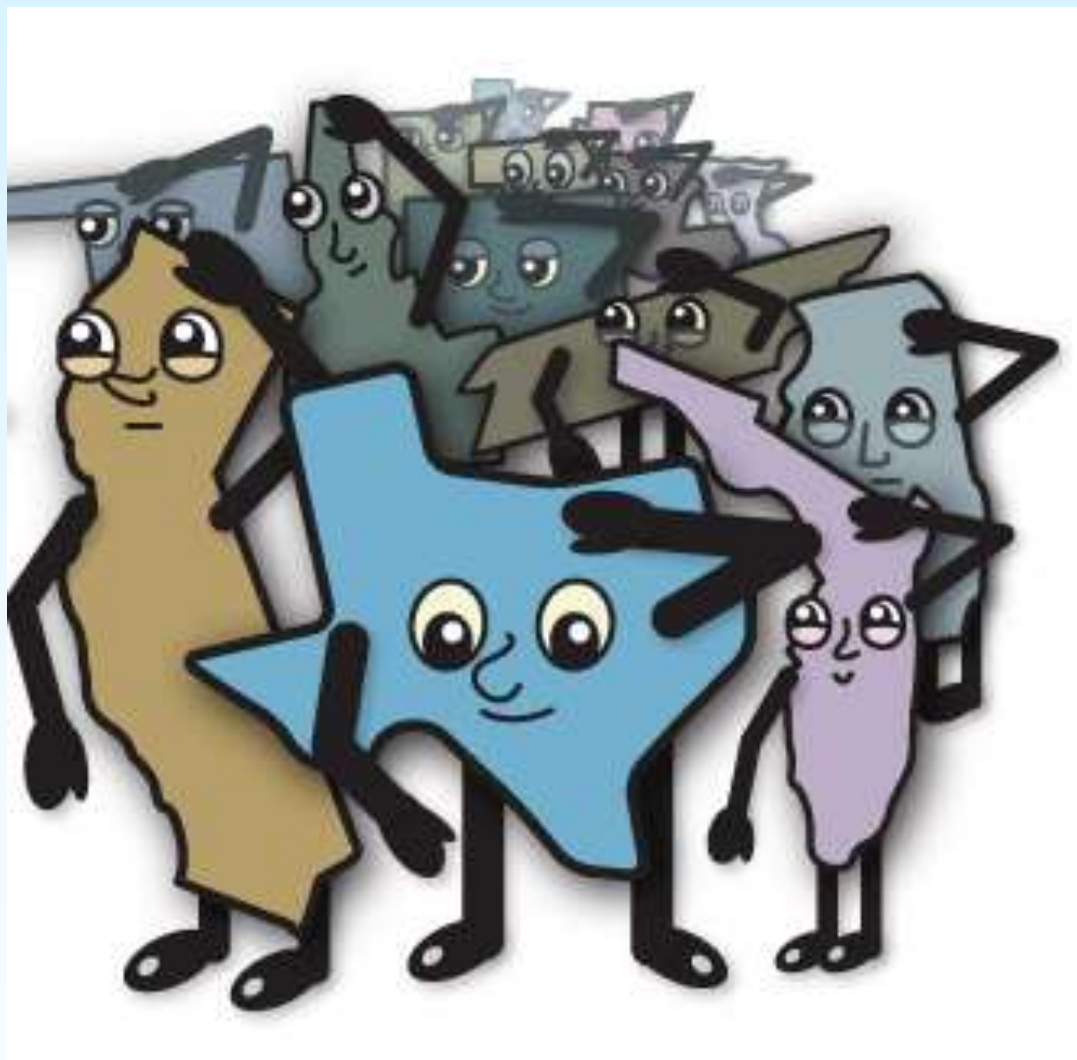
